

LOK KAWI WILDLIFE PARK

DURATION : 3 HRS

The Lok Kawi Wildlife Park is managed by the Sabah Wildlife Department. Occupying an area of 280 acres, it is one of the largest wildlife parks in Malaysia. It is home to a fascinating and varied collection of tropical animals comprising mammals, birds and reptiles. These animals live in large enclosures designed to be like their natural habitat. Water is used as barriers wherever possible, together with low fences and walls camouflaged with vegetation. This open environment concept provides for easy viewing and unique opportunities for wildlife photography. A botanical garden has been developed to highlight common plant species of the rainforest as well as some of the more unusual species such as pitcher plants.

TOUR ITINERARY

- 1000 hrs - Meet your guide at hotel lobby for tour to Lok Kawi Wildlife Park, a journey which will take approximately 45 mins south of the city of Kota Kinabalu.
- 1030 hrs - Arrive at the Wildlife Park, proceed to explore the various area of the park. This Wildlife park offers an opportunity to see the various animals and birds found in Borneo, meet The Wildman of Borneo, the "Orang Utans" or the Borneo Pygmy Elephant and many more interesting animals and birds.
- 1115 hrs - Watch the Animal Show where the Wildman of Borneo with guests in de-husking a coconut. (Animal Show is subjective to the weather conditions, if it rains the animal show will be cancel)
- 1215 hrs - Depart the Lok Kawi Wildlife Park for your hotel.
- 1245 hrs - Arrive at the hotel. End of Tour.

NOTE

- **What to bring:** - Wear comfortable walking shoes.
 - Sabah being in the tropics, it is advisable to dress light.
 - Bring your camera!
- **Minimum Pax:** 2
